Windows 7

OK so Windows 7 is here and what does it mean and is it another disaster like Vista. The best thing is that Windows 7 actually seems to be very stable and doesn't suffer many of the faults that plagued Vista. For those of you with new computers that came with a free upgrade to Windows 7 **BEWARE!!!** There is a thread on Microsoft's site about problems with the Vista to 7 upgrade. It seems that with quite a number of systems 7 gets 60-70% through the upgrade then goes into a reboot cycle you can't escape from. Based on what we have seen the best upgrade option is to backup your data (which you should do beforehand anyway) then reformat your hard drive and do a fresh install.

There have also been issues with 7 and iPhones. It appears that if your hardware uses the Intel P55 chipset then you can't sync your iPhone. So if this is important to you then my suggestion is to wait a week or two until there is a fix.

Overall Windows 7 is a giant leap forward after Vista, but as always if you don't need to wait until Service Pack 1 is released.
